CO-CURRICULAR CHARGES

Please see the separate booklet produced detailing charges for additional paid for activities such as music tuition, LAMDA lessons, dance tuition and sports coaching. In addition, there will be charges based on participation for the CCF (Combined Cadet Force) and DofE (Duke of Edinburgh's Award).

ACADEMIC EXTRAS

Termly bills will include academic extras such as textbooks and revision guides, public exams (e.g. GCSEs, A Levels and IB) and fieldtrips where required. Termly bills will also include material costs for those taking Art or Design GCSE or A Level exams – these will be reviewed with parents when expected to be in excess of £200 in total. In addition, students will be expected to bear the costs of lost or seriously damaged IT equipment such as laptops or styluses.

HOUSE SUBS AND EXTRAS

Students will be charged 'House Subs' each term to support social activities in the Houses. The activities will vary from House to House. In addition, specific extras such as dry cleaning, meals out, medication and taxis will be charged to the student's bill.

SCHOOL SHOP AND THE STODGE

Students are able to purchase items in the School shop including clothing and stationery. This will be charged to the student's bill. In addition, an 'allowance' is agreed with parents for the Stodge (the School Tuck Shop) which may be increased with approval from parents. Where parents have not previously set an allowance with the Fees Department, a temporary allowance of £30 per term will be allocated.

VISA COMPLIANCE FEES

A one-off charge of £450 plus VAT (£540) will be payable for each student requiring the School to support a Child Student Visa or Student Visa application.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT CHARGES

A termly charge of £90 plus VAT (£108) will be added to the School bill for international students, whether or not they are sponsored by the School for visa purposes. This fee covers the costs of ensuring ongoing compliance with statutory bodies regarding international students and enables the School to provide an enhanced service, prioritising the safeguarding of the students, as they travel from their homes to the School, for example through the support of Airport Guardians. Actual travel costs will be charged separately.

OPTIONAL INSURANCES

RUGBEIAN SOCIETY SUBS

Lifetime membership of the Rugbeian Society is charged based on the number of terms the student plans to attend and new students joining the School in 26-27 will pay £911 in total over their time at the School.

ANNUAL FEES

The annual fees for the School are divided equally between the three terms in order to calculate the above termly fees. Reductions will therefore not be offered for students who are not in School for part of the Trinity Term after the completion of their GCSEs, A Levels or IB examinations.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Please see the School's Terms and Conditions on the parental portal for further information about the payment of fees and extras. Copies are available on request from the Bursary.

Please note in particular that a full term's fees are due if a student is withdrawn without a full term's notice, in writing, to the Head Master.

REFUNDS OF THE ADDITIONAL DEPOSITS OR ENTRANCE FEES

Following completion of the student's time at the School, parents may elect either to receive a full refund of the Entrance Fee or Additional Deposit or to leave them with the School as a donation, in which case it will be used by the School to provide Arnold Foundation bursaries. Refunds will only be offered after the settlement of all outstanding bills, including the final bill of extras charged at the end of the student's final term in the School.

COMPOSITION OF FEES (FEES IN ADVANCE) SCHEME

If you would like to pay fees in advance, please contact the Finance Department (see below) who would be glad to help you use the School's Composition of Fees scheme. Any payment of fees by way of the Scheme will be against fees including VAT.

For those who paid into the Composition of Fees Scheme prior to 29 July 2024, the related fees will be adjusted accordingly dependent upon the VAT treatment. Please contact the Fees Administrator should you have any questions.
