

For Sale - Rare Cecil Aldin (1870 – 1935) signed coloured print 'Rugby School'

Cecil Aldin is best known for his characterful studies of dogs and horses. He also depicted a series of coaching Inns, cathedrals and schools including Winchester, Harrow and Rugby. A pupil wearing a blue and white hooped cap appears in the foreground, with a gowned figure walking through an arch in the background. This example is numbered 27 and signed in the margin.

Dimensions are 16" x 14"; frame is 27.5" x 23".

Arthur Penrhyn Stanley, later to become Dean Stanley, arrived at Rugby in 1829 to commence his studies, shortly after Dr Arnold became Head Master. Stanley was to go on to great things. Stanley House was named after him.

In 1882, the year after his death, he was sculpted by his wife's niece, the eminent Victorian sculptor Mary Grant. A marble version and a bronze cast in relief are in the possession of Westminster Abbey. A later version, dated 1884, is in the Royal Collection.






