As you will be aware, GDPR (the General Data Protection Regulation) will come into force on 25 May 2018. Over the last 18 months or so the School and the Rugbeian Society have been working closely in anticipation of this new regulation; you may recall receiving a form with recent editions of the Floreat on which we asked both for current contact details and your preference on how you would like us to keep in touch with you.
