Update on Search for Rugby School Fleming Scholars

The [original article](#) asking if you were a Rugby School Fleming Scholar went in the Floreat on-line bulletin in June 2018. This helped expand the known Rugby School Fleming Scholars from 10 to 18, but there are about 40 still to be found. All the Rugby School Fleming Scholars discovered so far were at schools in Hertfordshire: Hitchin Boys Grammar School; Watford Grammar School and Stevenage Alleynes to name a few.

The good news is that the deadline for the book on the Fleming Scholars has been extended into next year, to allow more time for research following the discovery of about 40 Mill Hill School Fleming Scholars supported by Middlesex. The big reunion planned at Eton has now been scheduled for the end of 2019 instead of the beginning.

The new deadline for Fleming Scholar biographies for the book is March 31st, 2019.

A BBC commission written by broadcaster and biographer Dr Kate Kennedy. The recital through music, song, poetry, letters and diaries, tells the story of the extraordinary friendship between the poet Rupert Brooke (Brooke 1901-06) and two Great War composers, F.S. Kelly and William Denis-Browne (James 1903-07).

The Fateful Voyage uses Rupert Brooke's words and Kelly and Brown's music to dramatise the three young men's last journey, their voyage to Gallipoli in 1915. Brooke died of septicaemia on the journey. Brooke's writings before his demise on the voyage are amongst the most well known poems of the war.

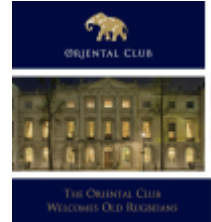
