


Michael A. K. Halliday (W 38-42) – appeal for information

Michael Halliday left the school in Easter 1942 at the age of 17 to become one of the "Dulwich boys", studying (in his case) Chinese at SOAS before serving as an intelligence officer in India.

He subsequently became a very distinguished professor of linguistics, latterly in Sydney, where he died in 2018. Dai Fan, herself a professor of linguistics, is presently writing a biography of Michael, but has practically no material from his time at Rugby. 


